NWC Programs and Fees

Nashua World Cup provides a comprehensive program for all players of all ages, of all abilities provided there are sufficient players/coaches within an age. This includes the player who is just starting out and premier teams for the dedicated player looking to get to the next level. The club fees are used to cover expenses including all applicable state/league registration fees, insurance, field usage fees, referee fees, training equipment and club administrative costs. **Convenient payment plans are used.**

Soccer Dojo (Winter Indoor Training)

The Soccer Dojo is World Cup's facility dedicated to the improvement of the individual soccer player. The goal is to make each player a master of the ball, through developing individual soccer skills.

Skills are developed through intensive training in small groups with dedicated professional trainers. The skills taught will be dependent on the age of the players. For the soccer player who wants to play at the highest level, the Soccer Dojo will develop individual techniques and foot skills.

In the Club (U9-U14) and Classic/Premier (U11-U18) divisions of Nashua World Cup, our teams compete in appropriate divisions of the Granite State Youth Soccer League (GSYSL) and the Massachusetts Premier League (MAPLE). They also attend prestigious soccer tournaments throughout the region. At U12 and above, our teams compete in the USYSNHSA State Cup or NH Open Cup.

Our dedicated coaching staff will provide your child with quality coaching so that they learn how to play and enjoy the great sport of soccer. We are committed to developing youth soccer players. Younger player programs focus on maximizing player development transitioning to a competitive travel program for older boys and girls. We draw players from all over the greater Nashua area: Amherst, Bedford, Brookline, Hollis, Hudson, Litchfield, Milford, Merrimack, Nashua, Wilton, Ayer (MA), Groton (MA), Lowell (MA) and Pepperell (MA). Players from Massachusetts may join Nashua World Cup with proper approval from both state soccer associations.

We have a very professional soccer club that is well respected throughout the Eastern Region of the United States. We expect that each player attend each of the two practices per week, and the game(s) on the weekends, unless you are excused by the coach. The club hosts two annual tournaments on Columbus Day and Memorial Day each year, which each family must volunteer 6 hours at.
